



## **PERSPECTIVE**

**A campaign of information to make aware and to prevent gender-based violence in the secondary school.**

The project PERSPECTIVE aims at putting in action some initiatives to prevent the gender-based violence inside new generations.

Violence against women is a worldwide matter, not enough faced and reported, as shown on some researches on this phenomena in many European countries. It is proved that such phenomena is very common inside the family itself, involving any kind of women from any kind of culture background.

Considered the importance of the consequences of this phenomena, often seen as a private business, it is very important to inform young people and awake them, in order to allow them to identify and face this problem and to report any kind of violence against women, as well as to prevent repetitive violent behaviors inside new generations.

To reach these objectives, a campaign has been organized to awake young people, implementing information activities in schools through the “peer education” methodology (education between peers). The aim is to rise the knowledge of adolescents in high school (14 to 17 years old) on the damaging effects that violence against women can have and to encourage zero tolerance towards any kind of violence.
