## Covid supplement to the educational co-responsibility pact

With regard to measures for preventing, containing and combating the spread of the Covid - 19 disease

| - measure the temperature of their child every morning before he/she leaves for school; - take their child to school ONLY IF: <br> 1. he/she does not have - and has not had in the previous three days - symptoms attributable to Covid-19, or a body temperature of $37.5^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$ or more; 2. he/she has not been in quarantine or selfisolation at home in the previous 14 days; <br> 3. he/she has not been in contact in the last 14 days, to the best of their knowledge, with people who tested positive for Covid-19; <br> 4. he/she wears a clean surgical face mask; <br> - promptly collect their child from school as soon as they are contacted by the teachers if the child shows symptoms of the disease. | - wash and sanitise his/her hands whenever necessary; - maintain physical distance from other students; - wear a face cover when moving around; <br> - avoid sharing items with other students (beverages, food, school materials, ...); <br> - never drink from taps because he/she uses exclusively personal bottles. | - make hand sanitising gel available to all pupils; <br> - provide each pupil with a personal bag to store his/her outer garments; <br> - repeatedly ventilate the school premises throughout the day; <br> - thoroughly clean bathrooms, classrooms, (canteens), communal areas and furnishings, also using special virucidal products; <br> - organise a dedicated Covid space for those who show symptoms attributable to Covid-19 and/or have a temperature higher than $37.5^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$ until their parents come to collect them; <br> - call the parents immediately, if a pupil shows any symptoms, so he/she can be leave the school premises as quickly as possible. |
